Green Adventure Fleet – Sailing Essentials



- **Adventure program** – sailing is fun and an adventure
- **Course:** learn to sail (beginners to early intermediates)
- **Boats:** Hobie Waves / OpenSkiffs
- **Ages:** 8 - 12
- **Days:** Tuesdays 4.30 – 6.30pm & Sundays 9am - 12pm (Refer to Sailing Club Calendar)
- **Cost:** Series 1 – (Sharing club boats) \$550 (pre Christmas), Series 2 - \$500 (Feb to before Easter)
- **Cost:** Series 1 – (own boat or chartered) \$450 (pre Christmas), Series 2 - \$400 (Feb to before Easter)
- The green adventure fleet is a great fun way to start sailing or build on previous experiences. Get used to the wind, water and boats and get a bit of adventure into your life
